The VA teacher will lead the charge in establishing a schoolwide appreciation for the visual arts and creative thinking.

MAIN DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan, develop, and implement art and art history curriculum to meet learning goals
- Provide a purchase list of art materials and maintain the inventory of art materials
- Prepare and arrange art materials and art equipment in the classroom for students to use
- Deliver lectures to students on art, art techniques, art history, and aesthetics give drawing and painting demonstrations to students to teach them art techniques
- Instruct students in working on different drawing, painting, and colouring techniques
- Discuss various artistic approaches and traditions and encourage students to express themselves artistically
- Provide instruction in the use of pencils, pens, charcoal, brushes, watercolours, acrylic, oil colours, and other art materials
- Assign art projects to students, grade the finished art projects, conduct art exams and maintain records of the students' progress
- Organise art exhibitions to display the artworks of students and help them develop their art portfolios
- Support the school administration in developing art programs, attend faculty meetings and participate in parent-teacher discussions
