The Visual Arts teacher will provide high-quality instruction, guidance, and leadership in the visual arts programme to ensure meaningful learning experiences and strong artistic outcomes for students.

The teacher will play a key role in fostering a schoolwide appreciation for the visual arts by designing and delivering engaging, developmentally appropriate art sessions that encourage creativity, self-expression, and critical thinking. The role also contributes to enriching the broader educational experience of students through the integration of visual arts within the Christel House model.

MAIN DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Visual Arts

- Plan, develop, and implement art and art history curriculum to meet learning goals.
- Provide a purchase list of art materials and maintain the inventory of art materials.
- Prepare and arrange art materials and art equipment in the classroom for students to use.
- Deliver lectures to students on art, art techniques, art history, and aesthetics give drawing and painting demonstrations to students to teach them art techniques.
- Instruct students in working on different drawing, painting, and coloring techniques.
- Discuss various artistic approaches and traditions and encourage students to express themselves artistically.



- Provide instruction in the use of pencils, pens, charcoal, brushes, watercolors, acryl, oil colours, and other art materials.
- Assign art projects to students, grade the finished art projects, conduct art exams and maintain records of the student's progress.
- Organize art exhibitions to display the artworks of students and help them develop their art portfolios.
- Support the school administration in developing art programs, attend faculty meetings and participate in parent-teacher discussions.
- Prepare students for internal and external visual arts competitions.
- Lead the preparation process for SBAs for all Visual Arts students.
